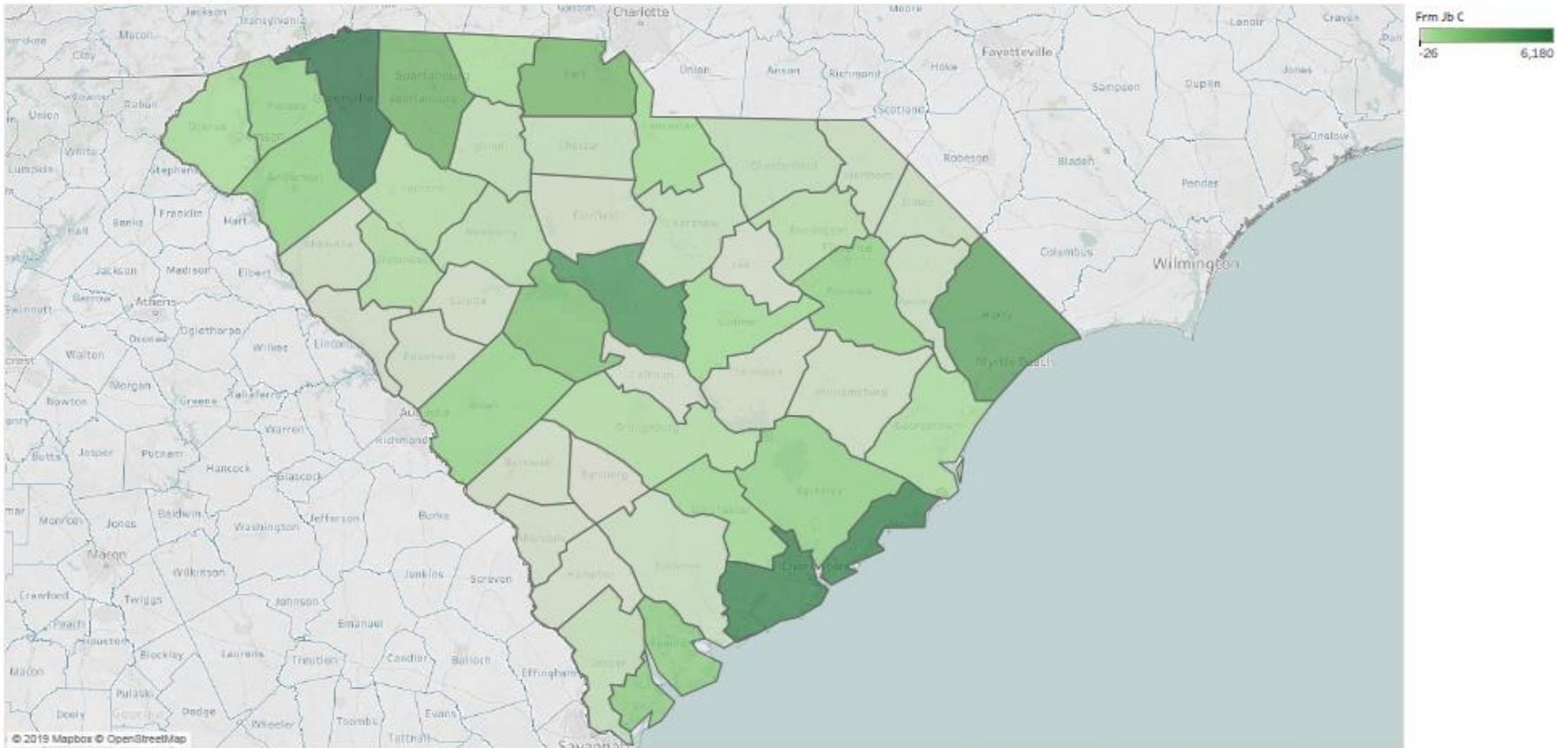

- Tables display average monthly earnings and job turnover by industry for each county.

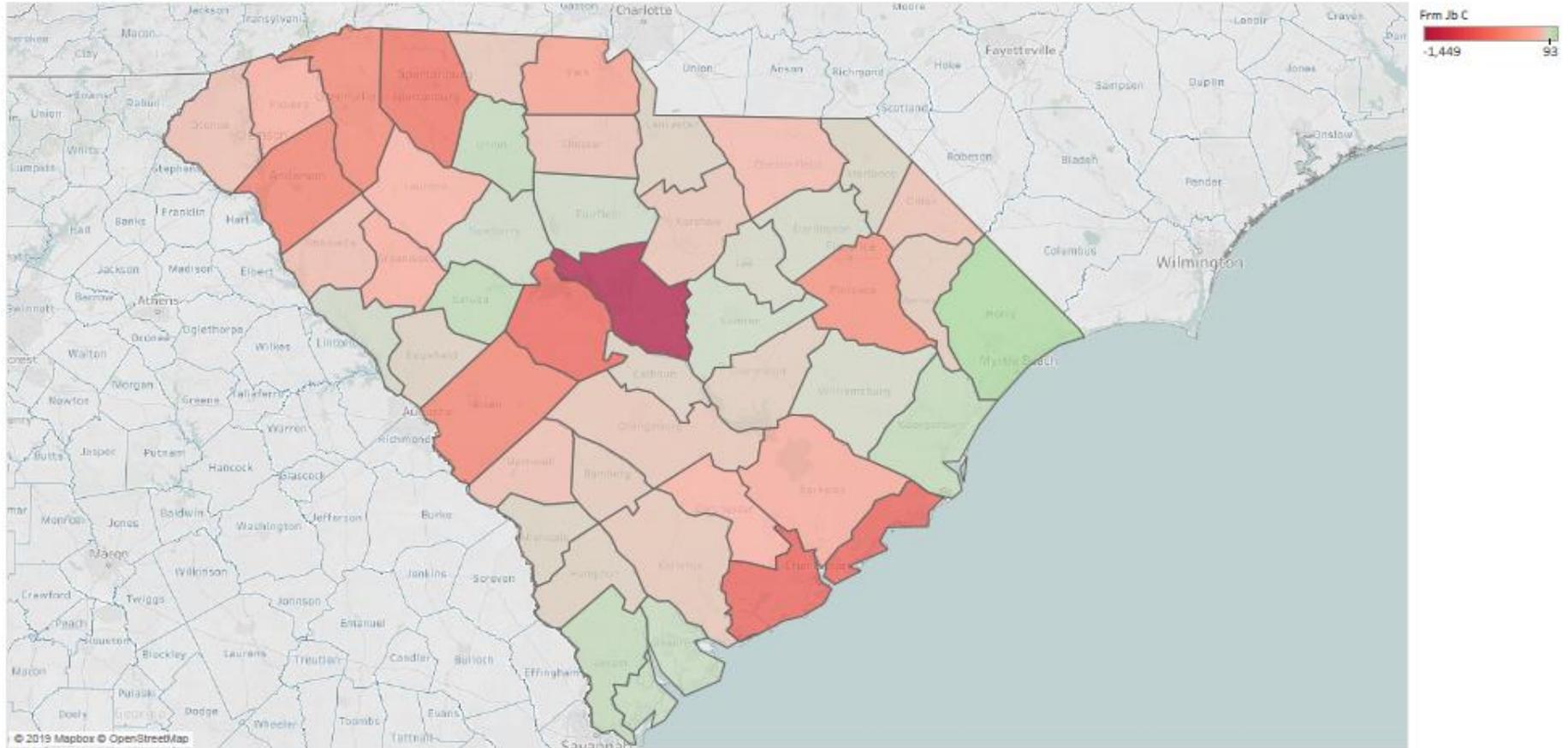

Job Change by County for Worker Ages 14-24, 2018



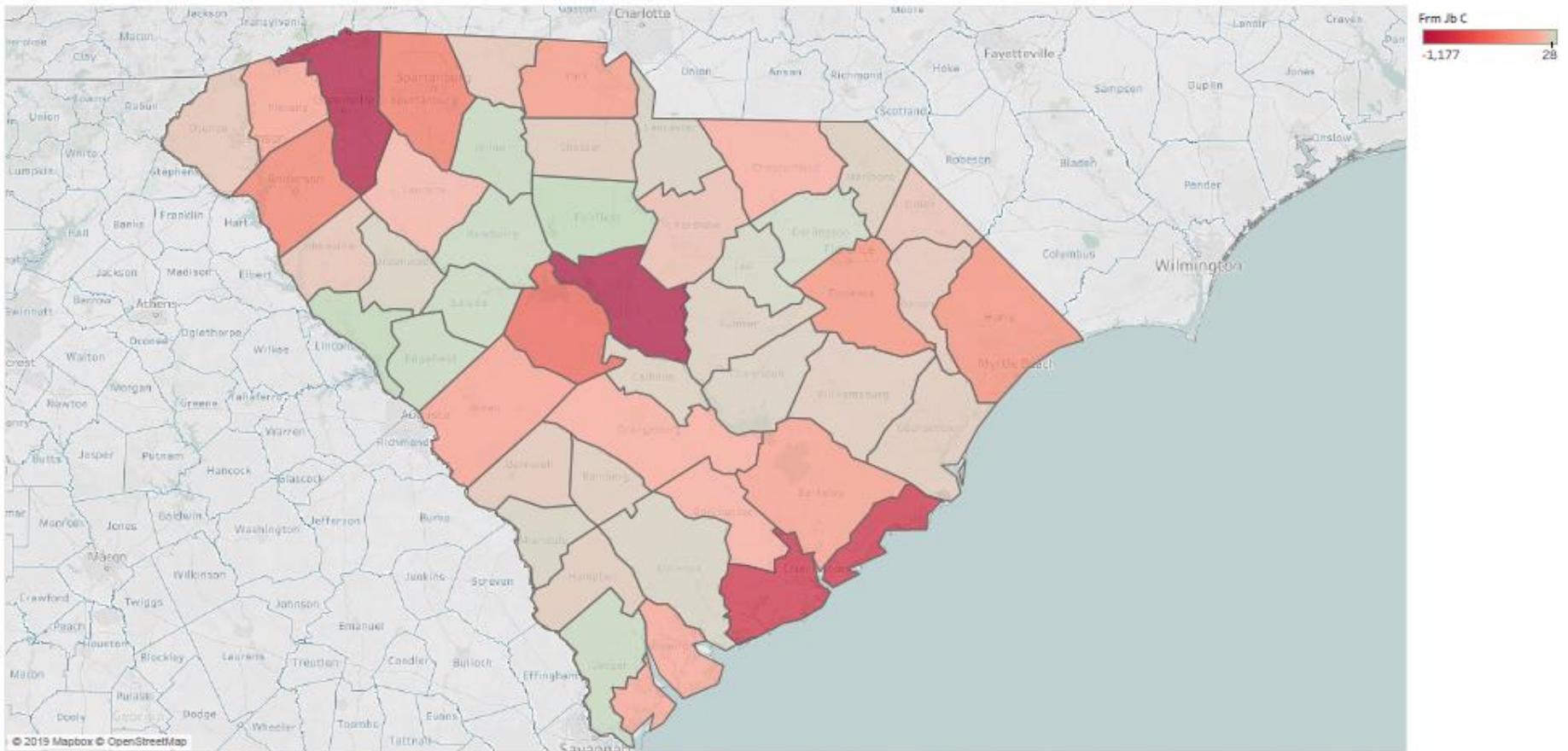

Job Change by County for Worker Ages 55-64, 2018



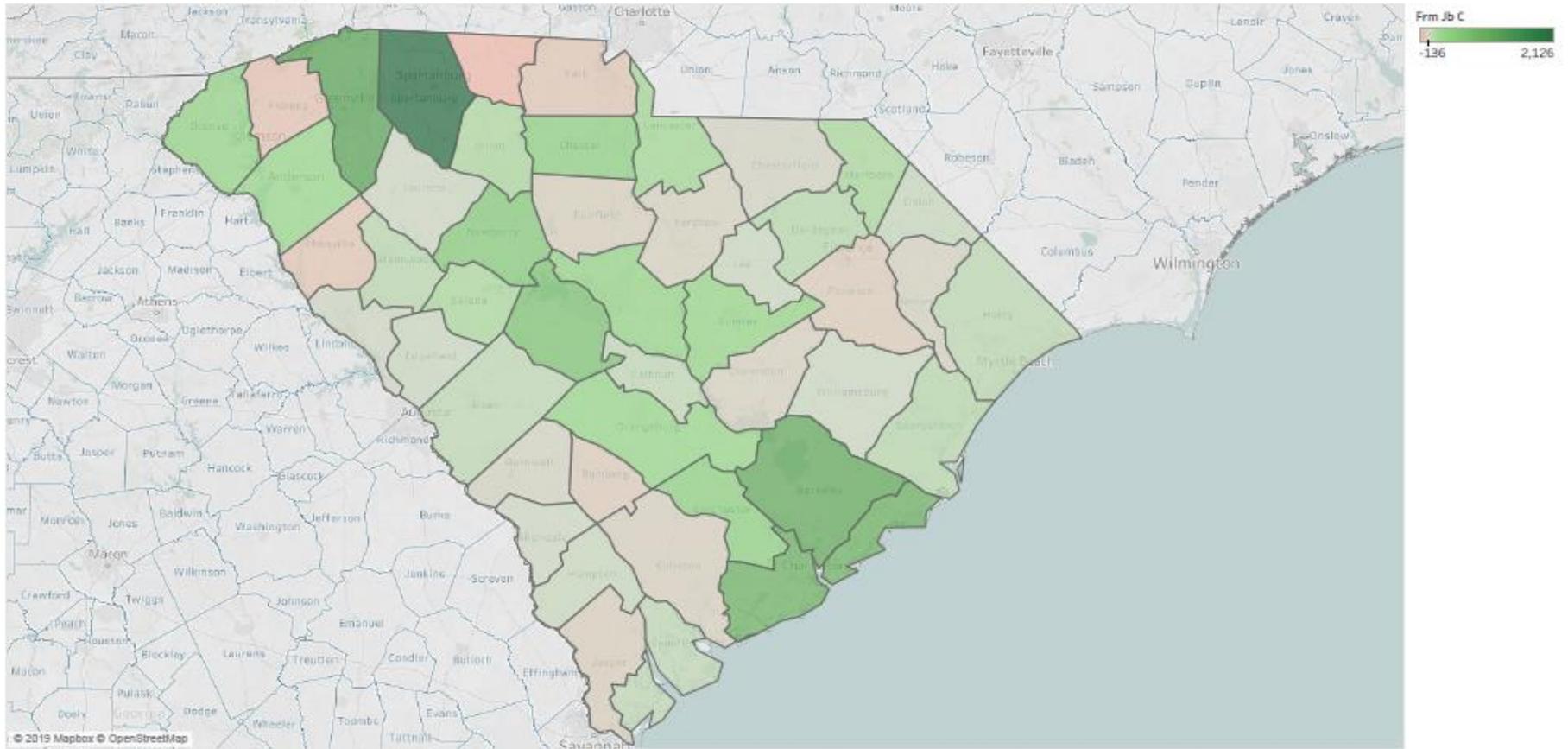

Job Change by County for Worker Ages 65+, 2018



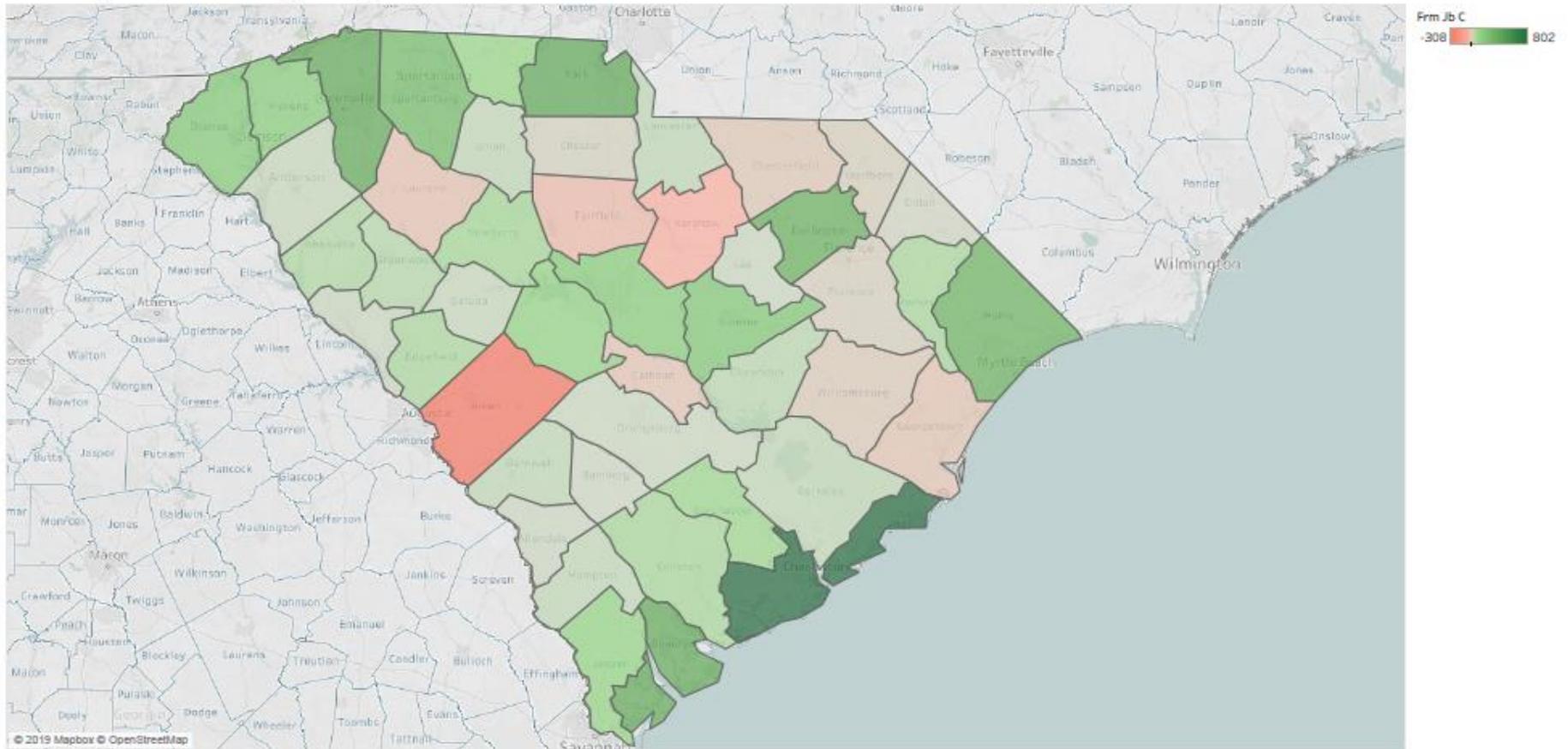

Job Change in Manufacturing by County, 2018



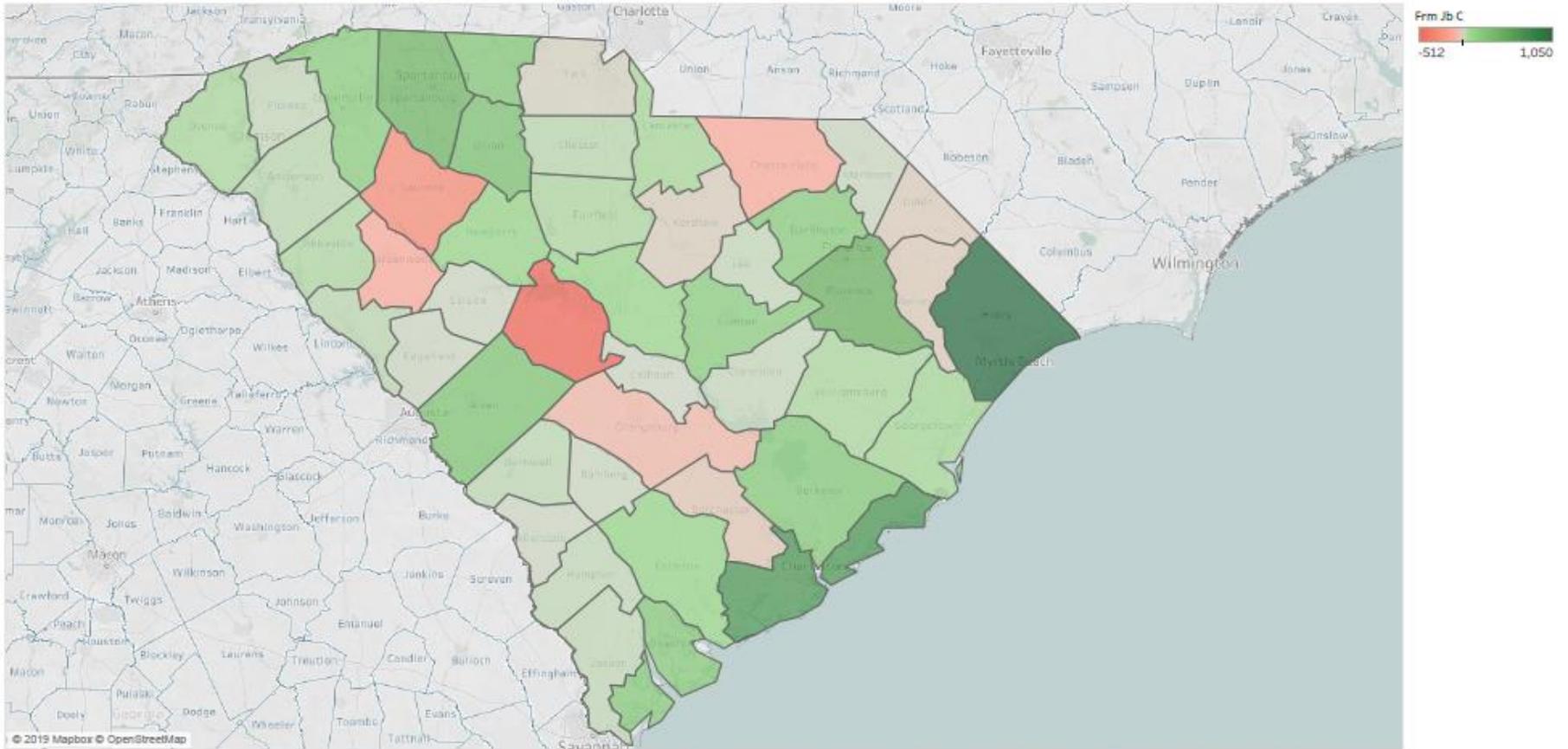

Job Change in Construction by County, 2018



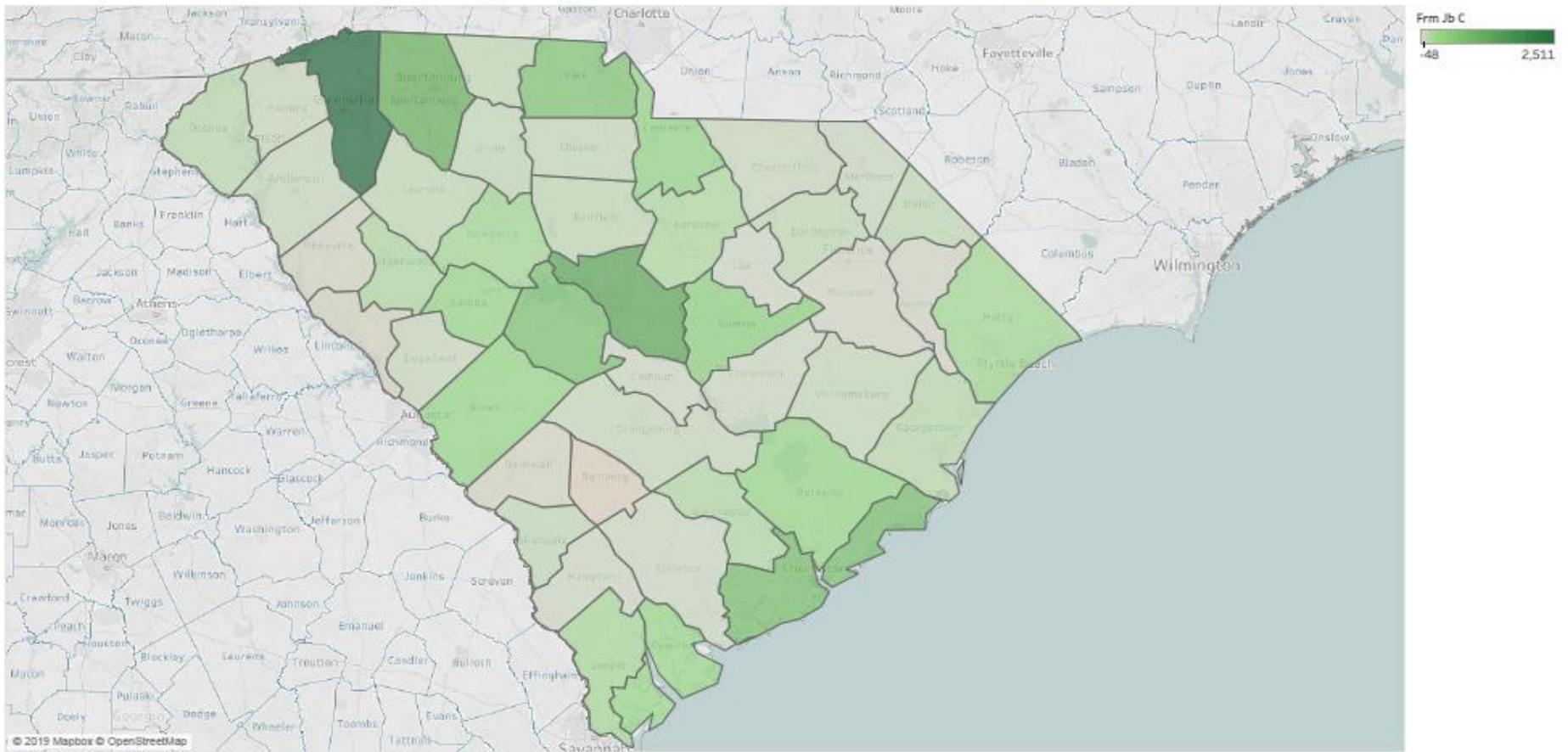

Job Change in Admin Support and Waste Mgmt by County, 2018



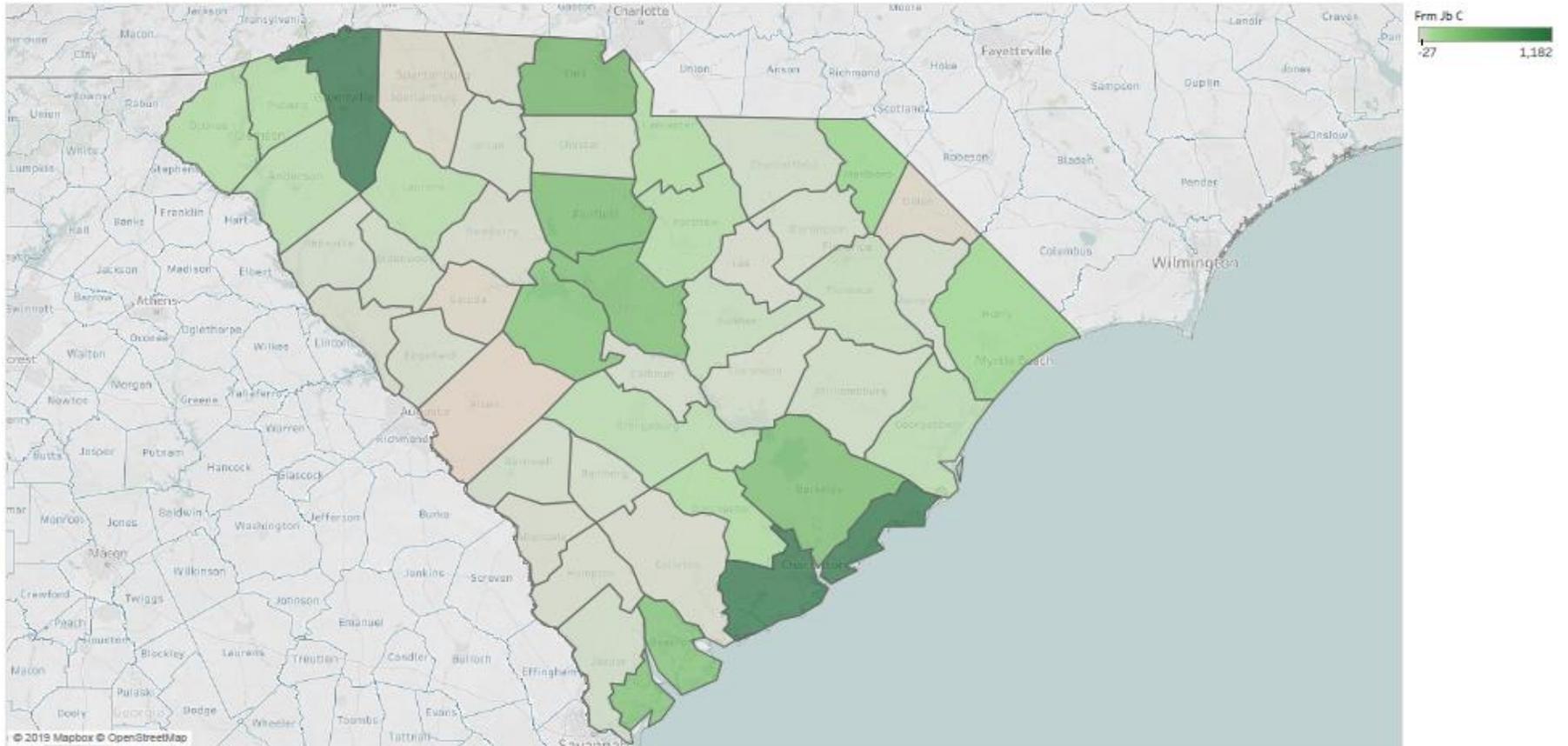

Job Change in Health Care and Social Assistance by County, 2018



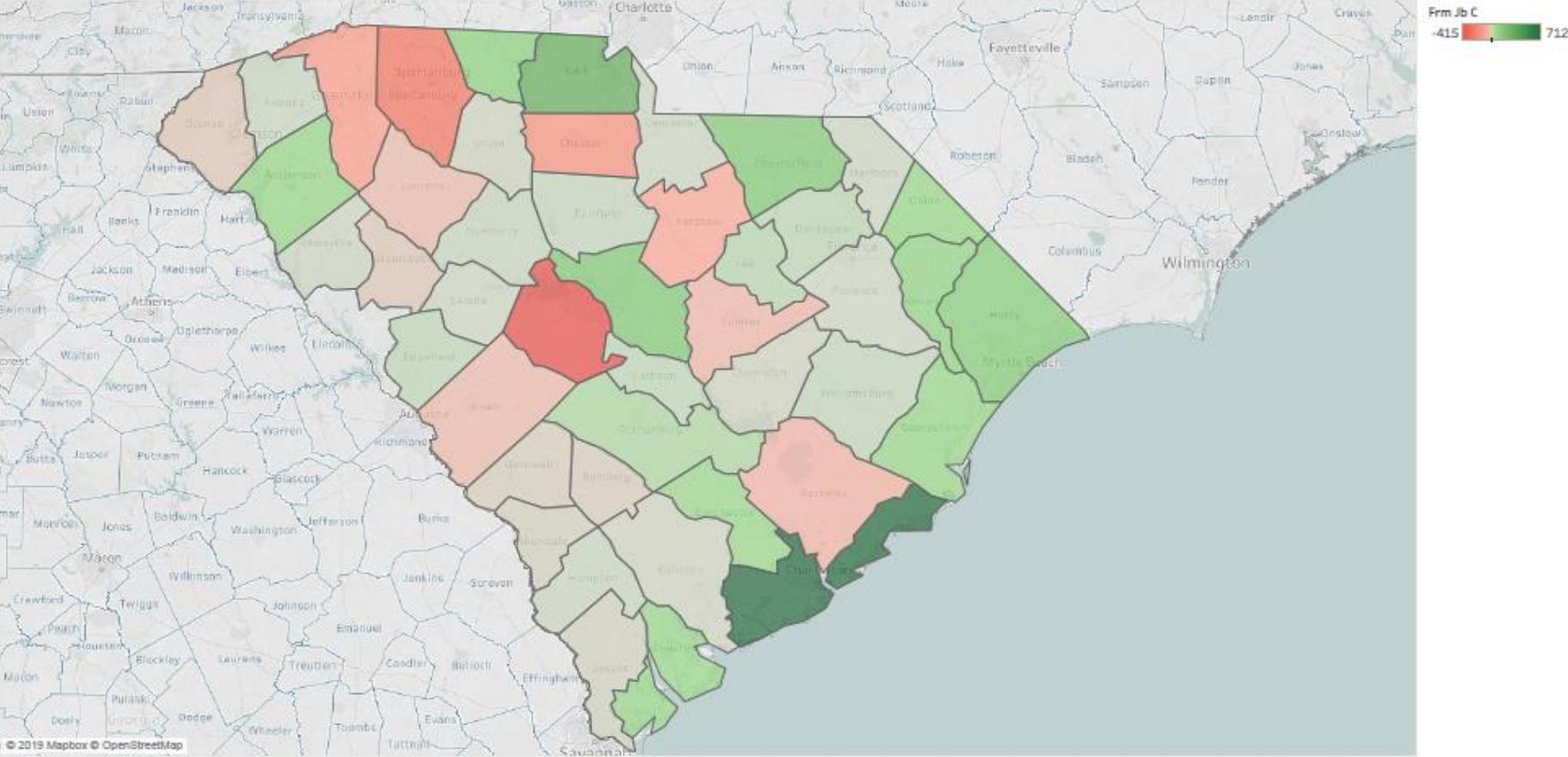

Job Change in Professional, Scientific & Technical Services by County, 2018



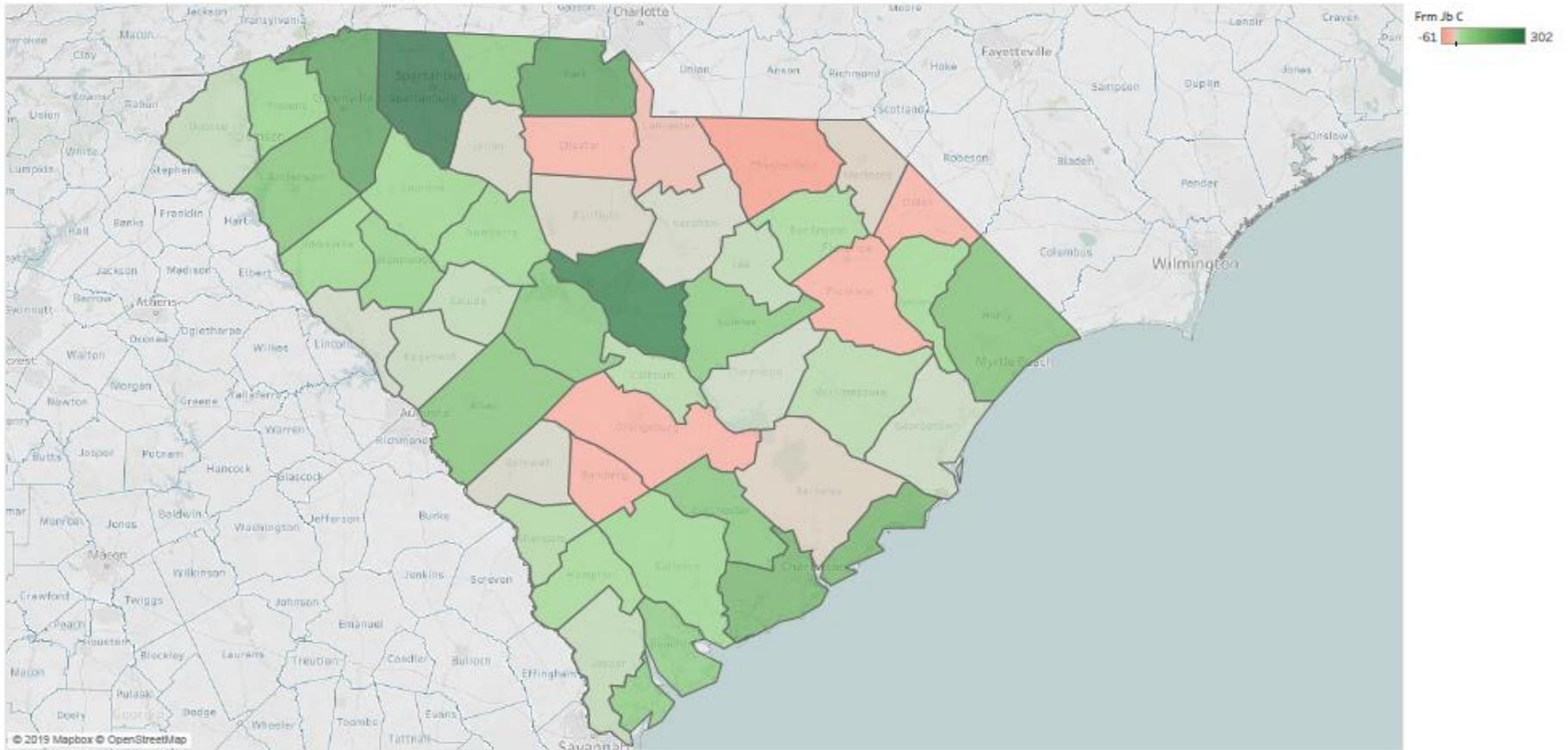

Job Change in Transportation and Warehousing by County, 2018



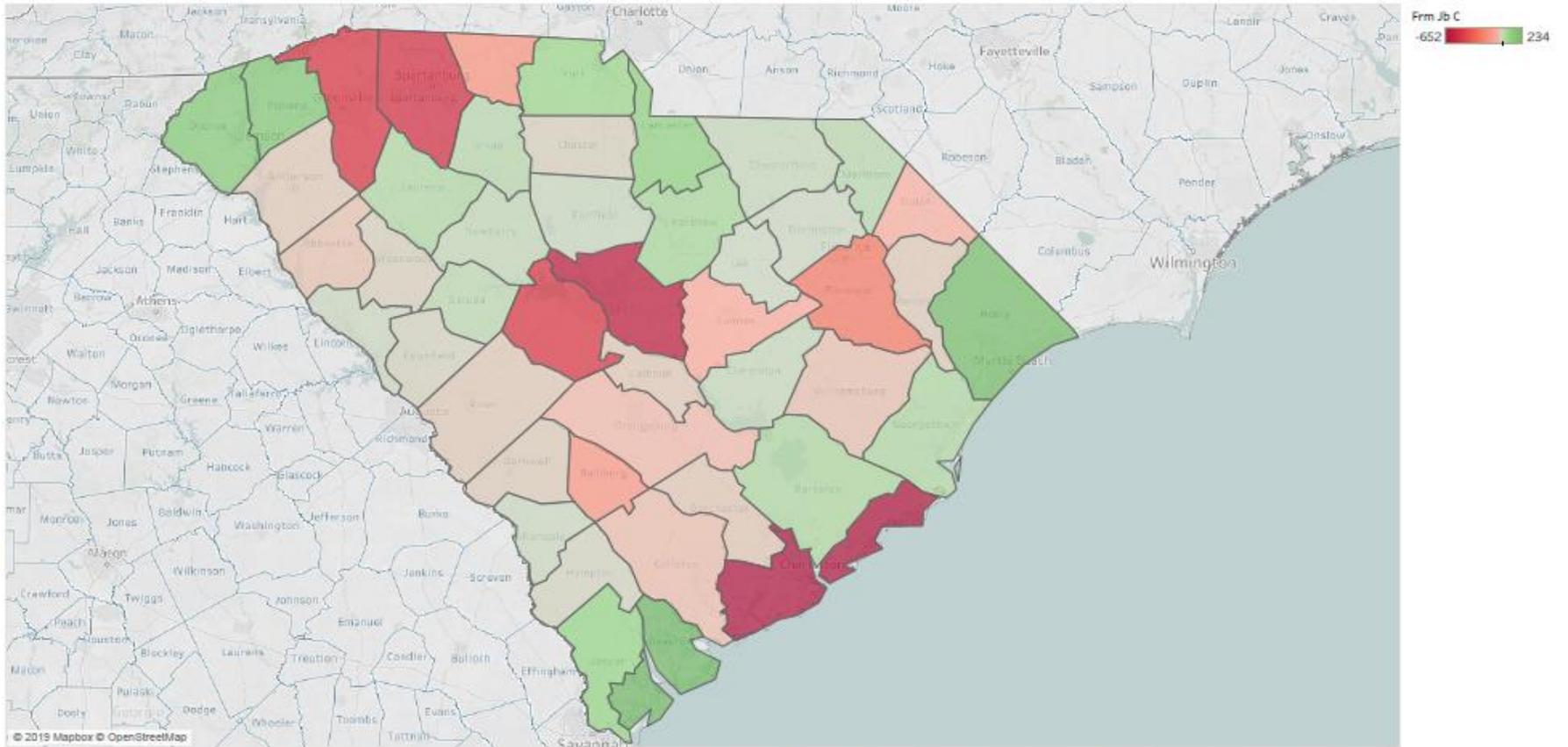

Job Change in Wholesale Trade by County, 2018



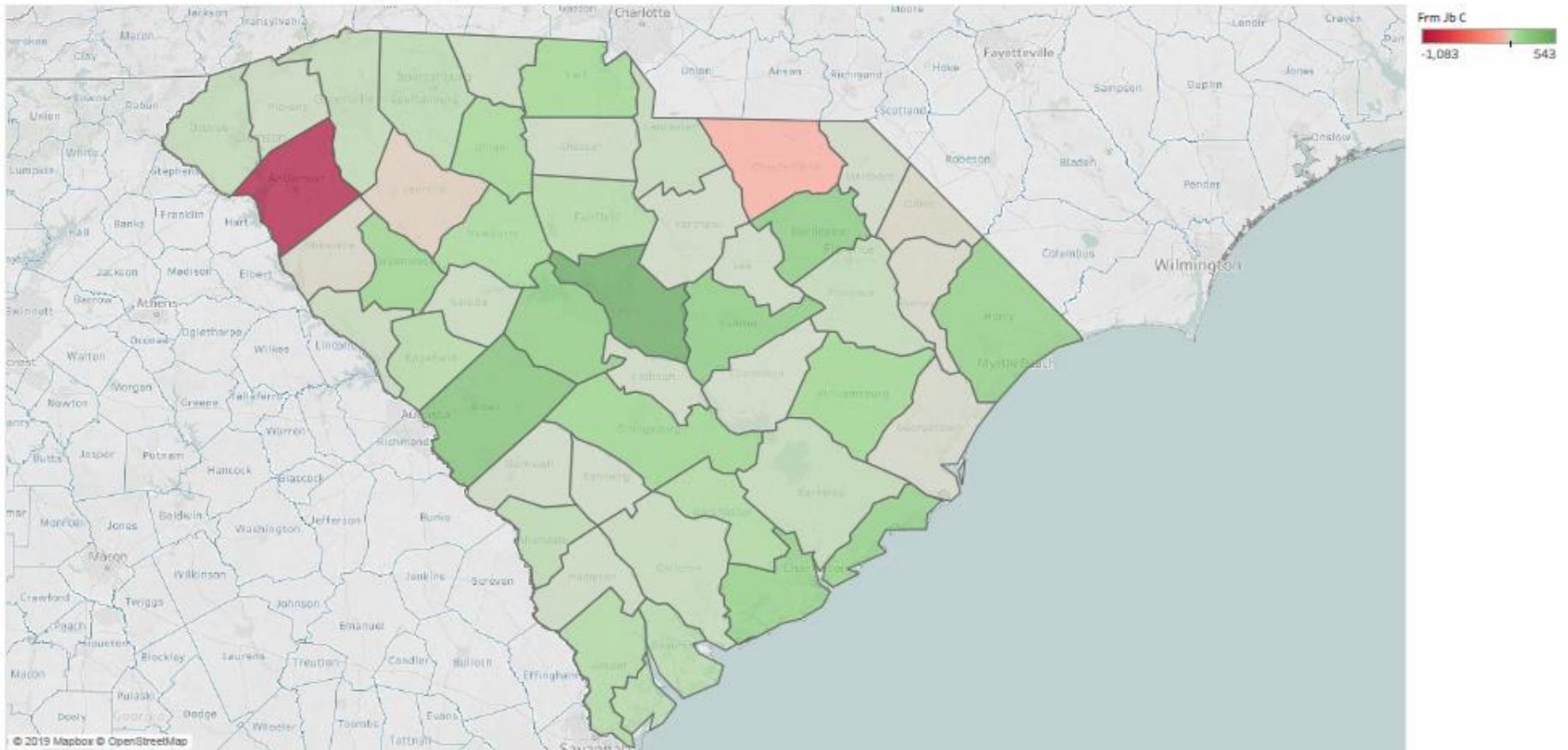
