



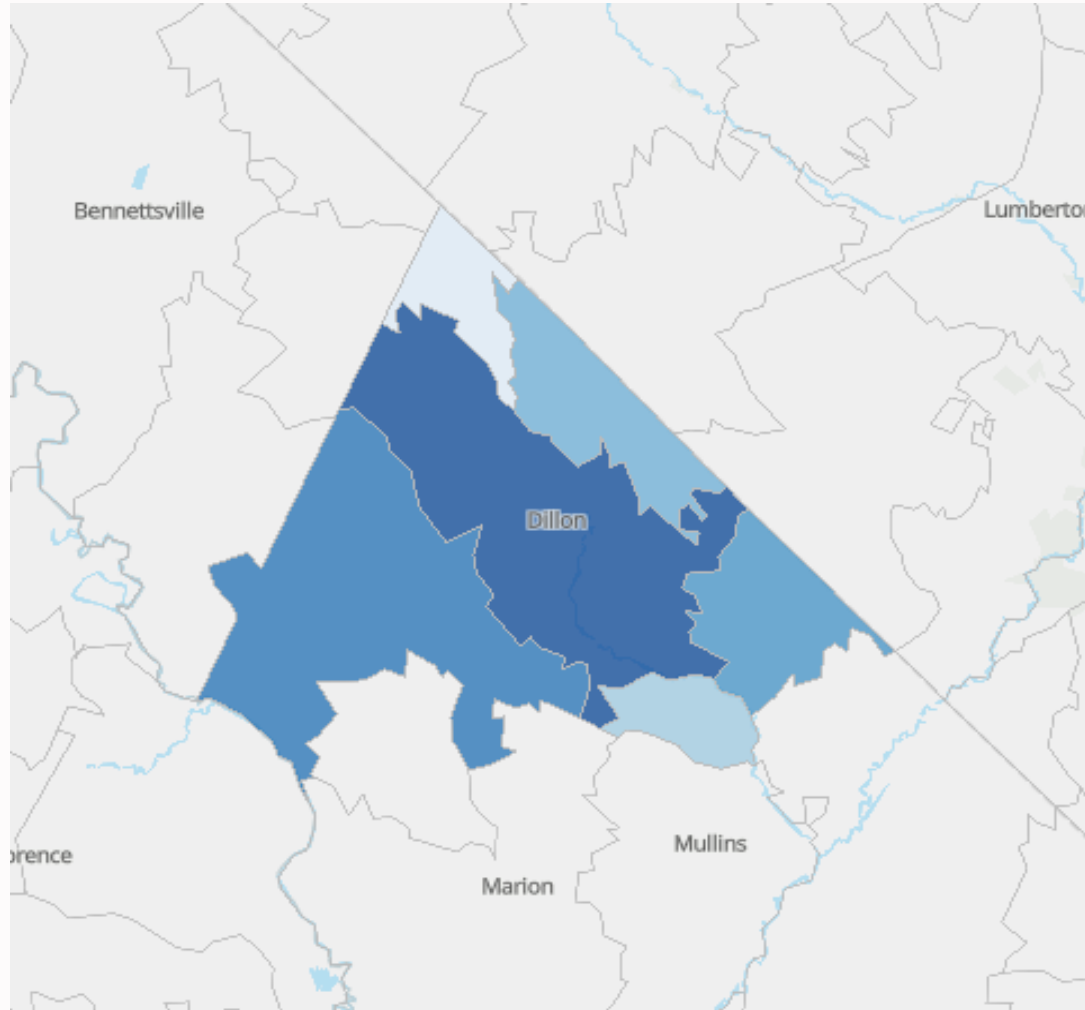

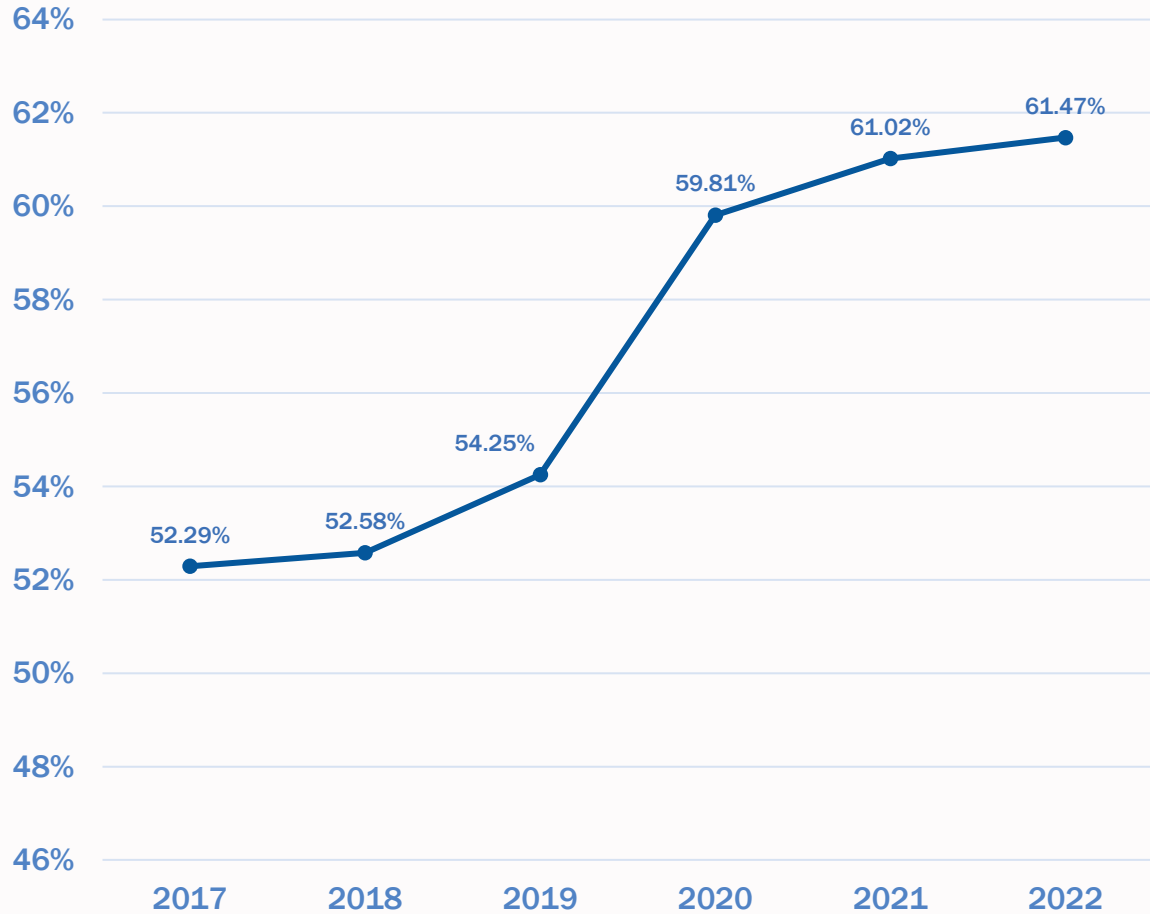

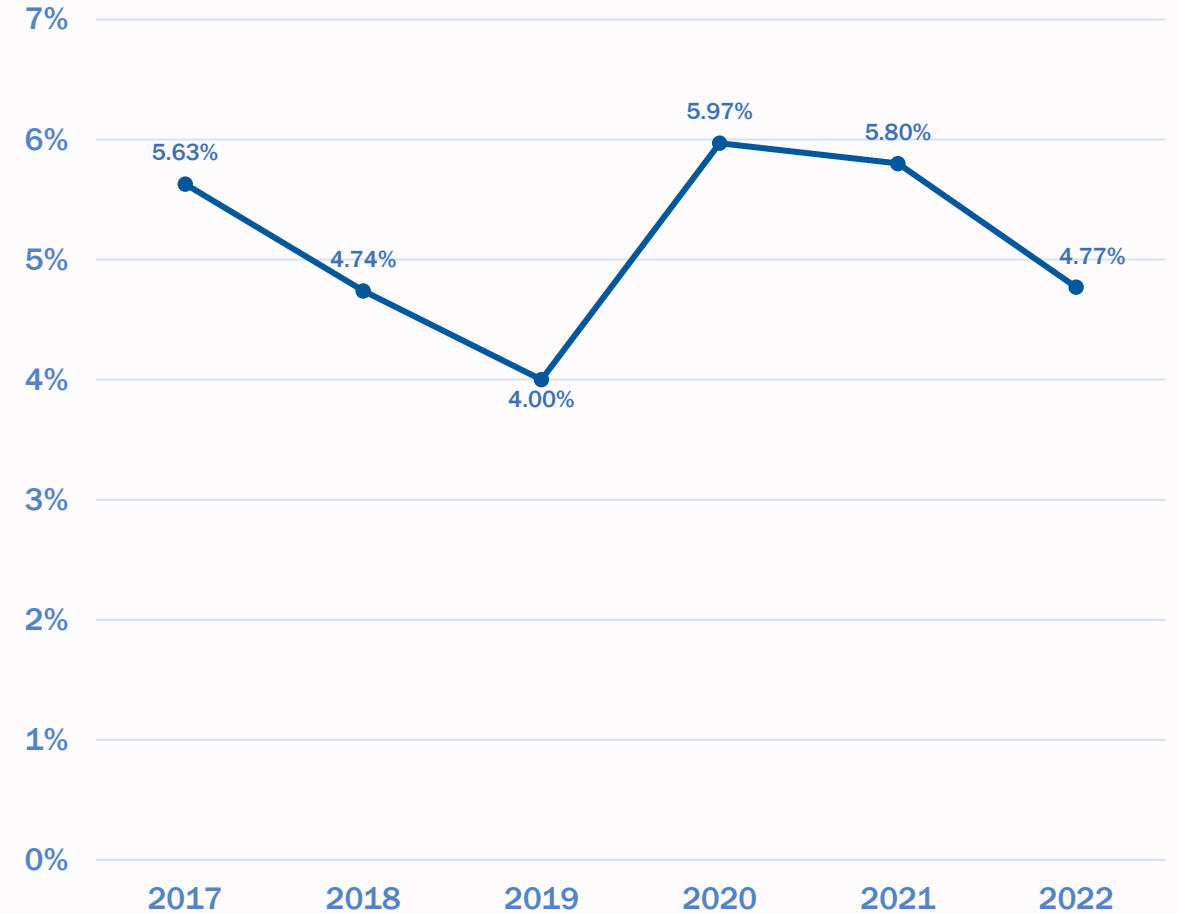

Labor Force Participation Rate



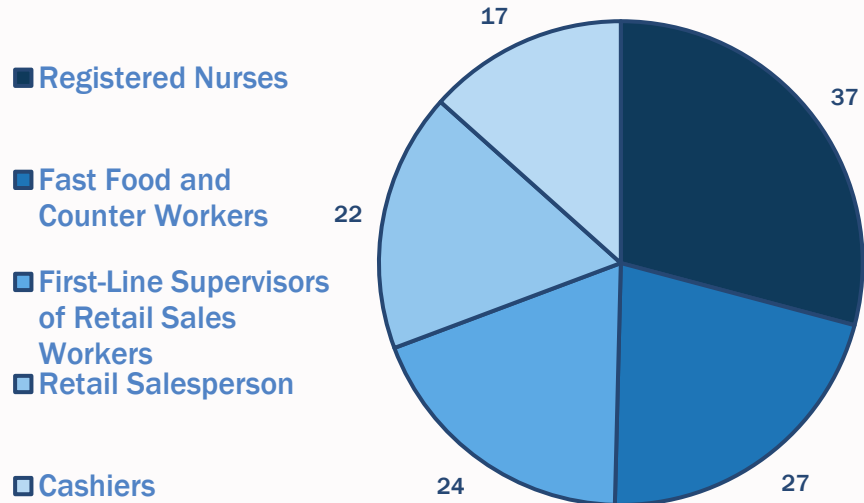

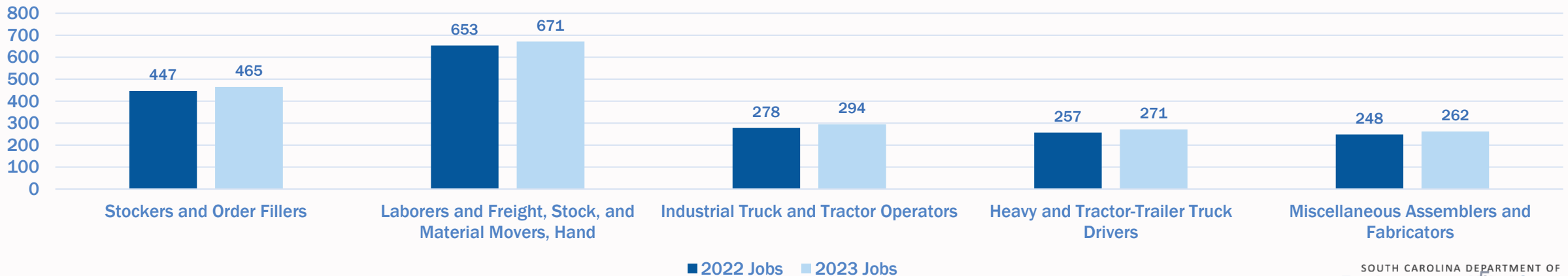

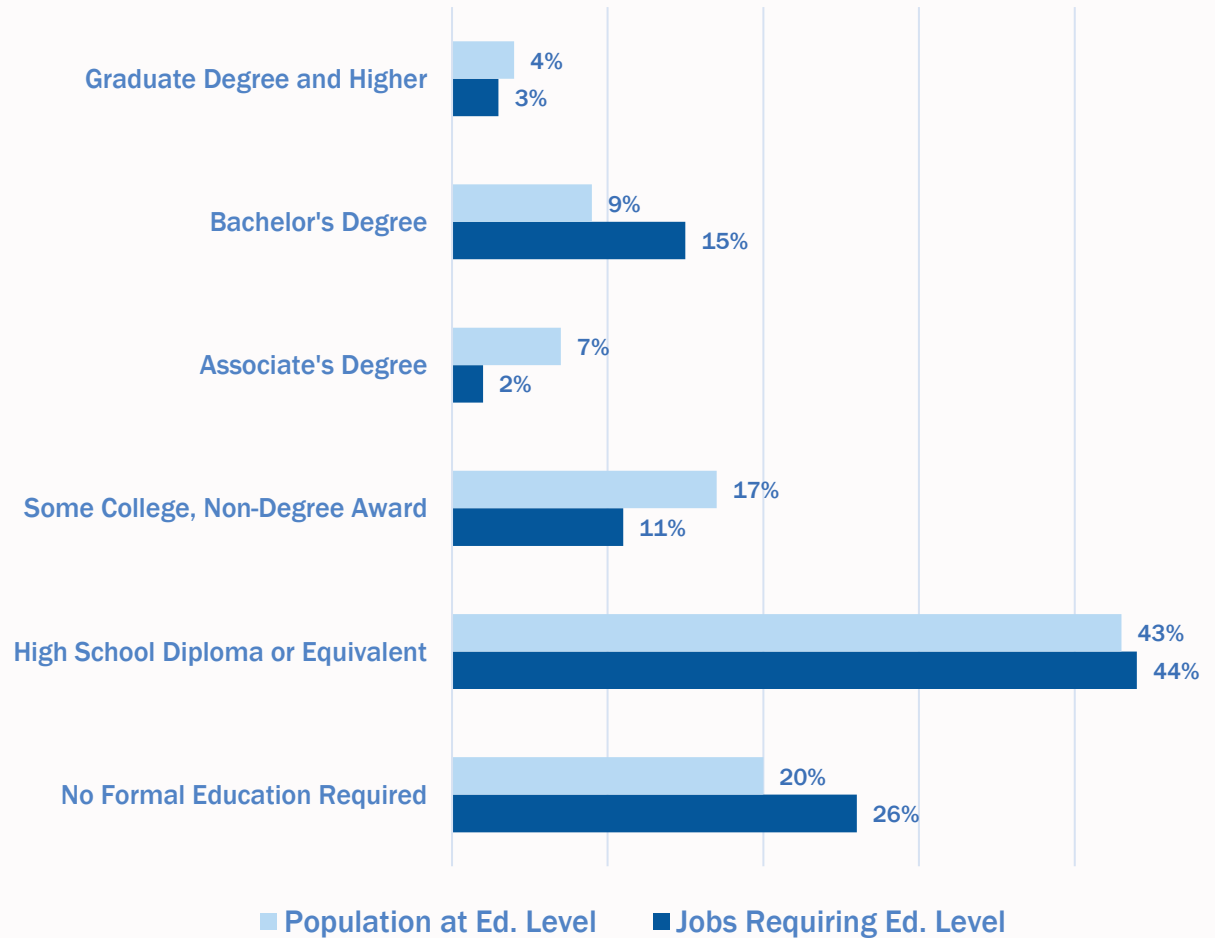

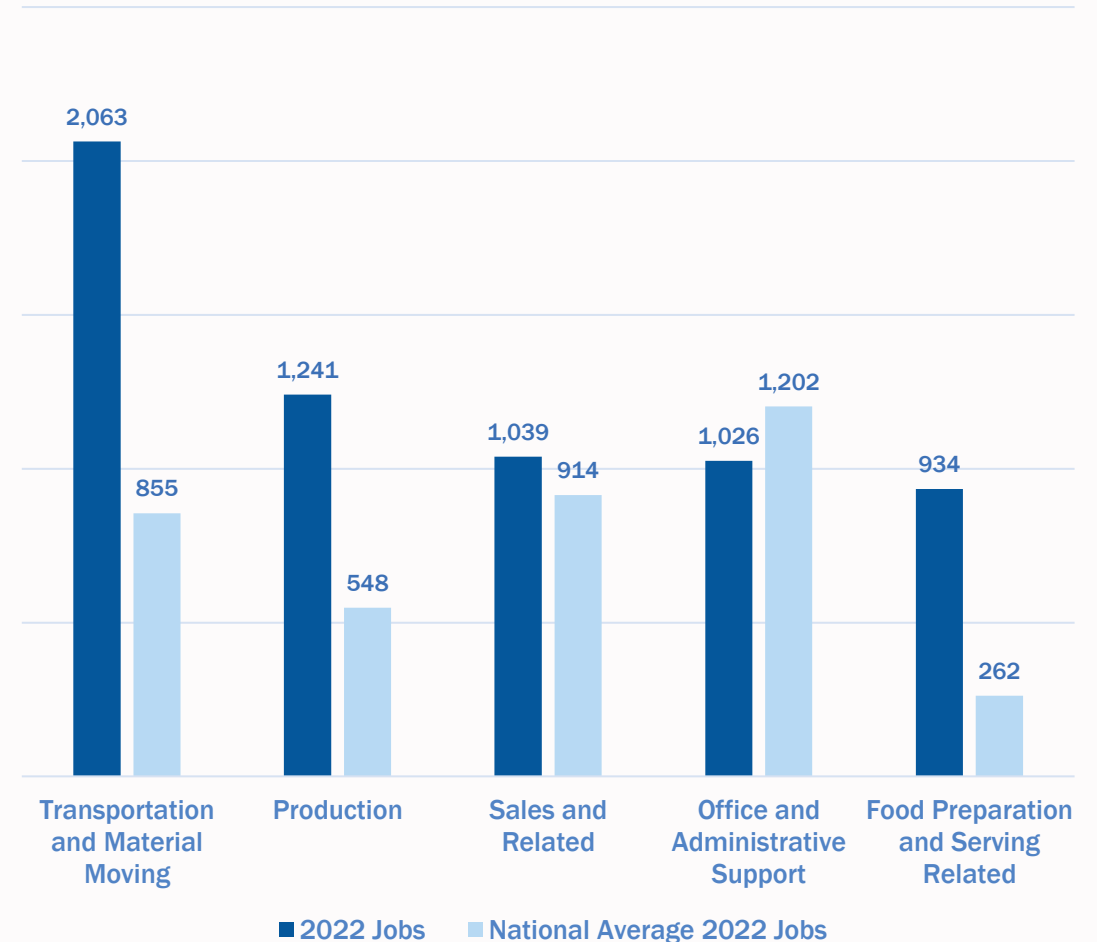


Dillon County Workforce Characteristics

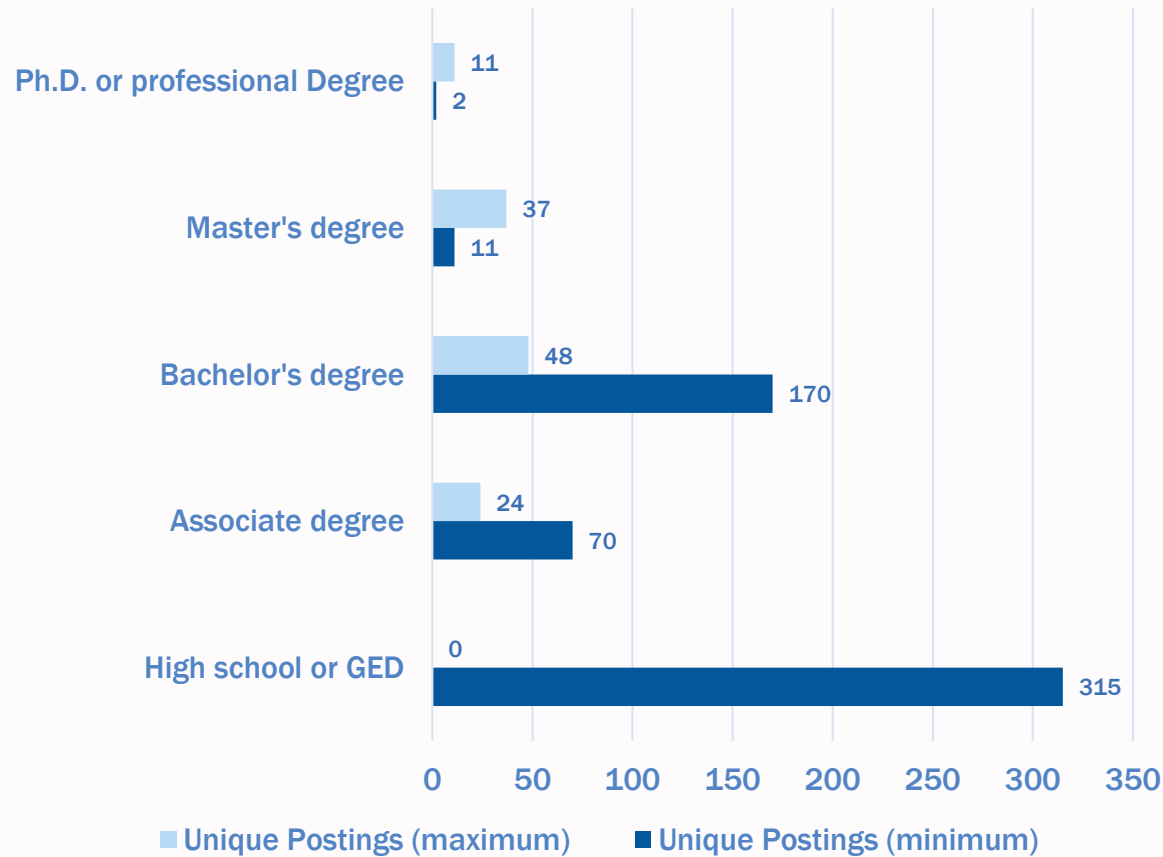
