
Current State of the Workforce

Employment and Unemployment



The unemployment rate within all counties in the Catawba WDA has risen significantly compared to April 2023, with Chester County increasing from 3.1% to 4.0%. Additionally, Lancaster County, York County and the Catawba Workforce Development Area (WDA) are all at or below the South Carolina April 2024 unemployment rate of 3.2%.

S.C., Catawba & County Unemployment Rate - Last 13 Months



All Catawba counties increased in their unemployment numbers over the past 13 months; with York increasing by 808, Lancaster increasing by 274 and Chester increasing by 137.






Average Employment and Average Weekly Wage

Catawba Average Industry Employment, Q4 2023





Within Chester County Manufacturing dominates employment with one-third of all jobs (3,400), followed by Health Care and Social Assistance with about 1,000 jobs. Wholesale Trade ranks in the third spot with 927 jobs.







AVERAGE WEEKLY WAGE

The average weekly wage by industry across the Catawba WDA shows that Management of Companies and Enterprises is leading the way, followed by Utilities and Professional & Technical Services industries with average wages at over \$2,000 each. At the other end of the spectrum is the Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation industry with average wages at just about \$400 a week.

Catawba Average Weekly Wage by Industry, Q4 2023





AVERAGE WEEKLY WAGE

The average weekly wage by industry within Chester County shows that Professional & Technical Services industries far outpaces the rest with average wages of about \$3,715 a week. This is followed by Wholesale Trade and Construction at just under \$1,500 each. Accommodation and Food Services is the lowest at \$367 a week.


Chester County Average Weekly Wage by Industry, Q4 2023

Lancaster County Average Weekly Wage by Industry, Q4 2023





Catawba Top In-demand Occupations Over the Past Year






TOP IN-DEMAND OCCUPATIONS

CHESTER COUNTY OCCUPATION SNAPSHOT

The top two Chester county major occupation groups based on employment as of Q4 2023 are Production and Transportation and Material Moving. Both of these major occupation groups have the highest amount of total demand, with more being due to transfers. Out of the major occupation groups listed, Healthcare Practitioners and Technical has the highest projected one-year growth forecast of 1.7%. Healthcare Support has the highest projected annual growth rate of 2.4% out of all occupation groups.





The top two York county major occupation groups based on employment as of Q4 2023 are Office and Administrative Support and Transportation and Material Moving. Food Preparation and Serving Related occupations have the highest amount of total demand, at 2,371. Out of the occupation groups listed, Healthcare Practitioners and Technical and Business and Financial Operations occupations have the highest projected one-year growth forecast, both at or above 2%. Healthcare Support and Computer & Mathematical have the highest projected annual growth rates of 2.7% out of all occupations.



Catawba & County Gender








Lancaster County has the highest percentage of those who are aged 55+, at 34.1%, followed by Chester County, at 33.1%.

Catawba & County Age









DEMOGRAPHICS – RACE & ETHNICITY






EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, AGE 25 TO 64

Catawba & County Education





Median Household Income






